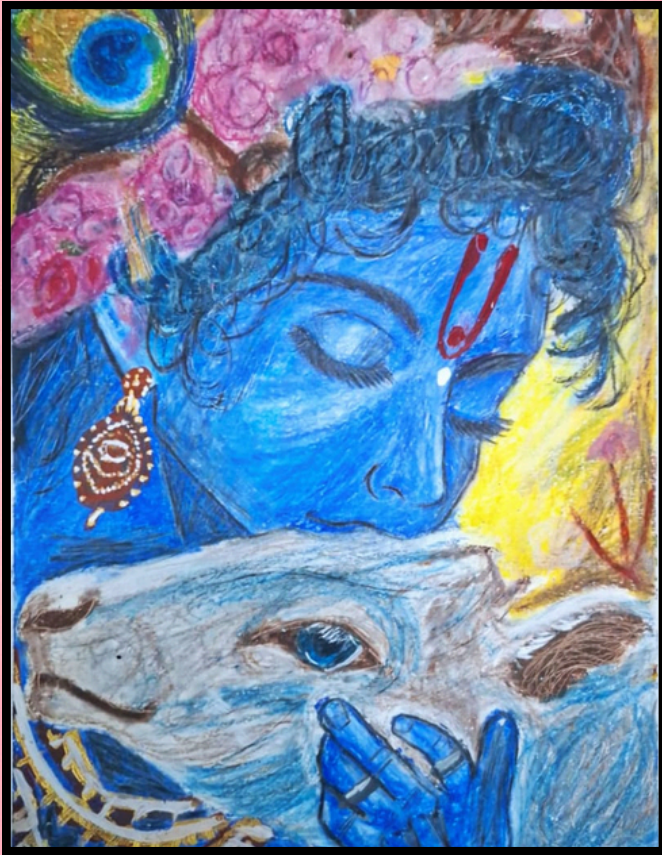
And thus, a new chapter began – not just for the kingdom, but for Oliver himself. The orphaned boy was now the prince of Ashland.

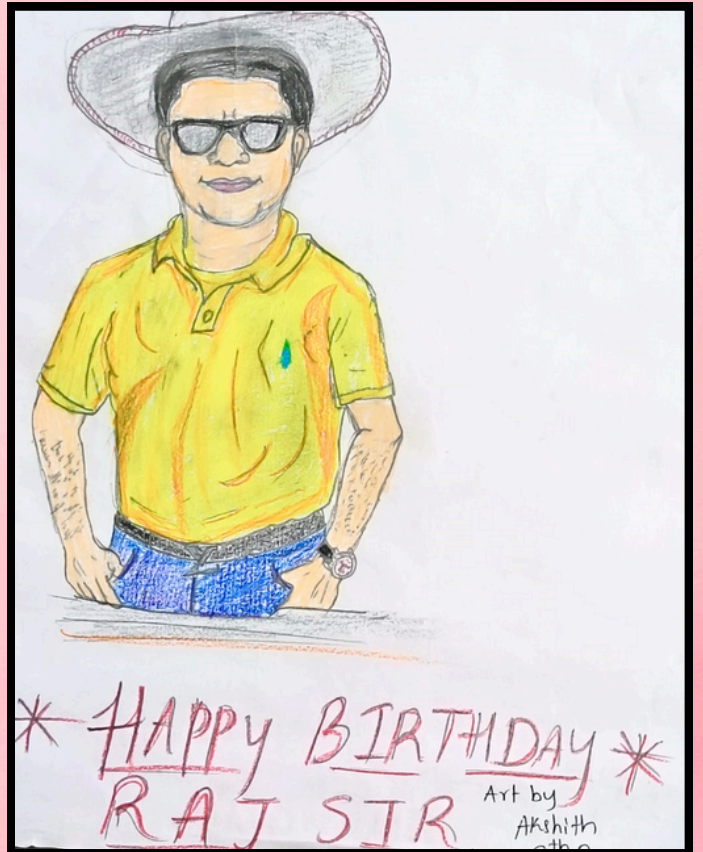
